





Topic: "Choice of Agency Devices in Business and Social Science Writing: Practical Advice for Handling the Tough Stylistic Options"

Keynote Speaker: *Prof. Peter J. Morton Center for Language Teaching and Learning Chinese Culture University*



Abstract

Academic writers face some tough choices in how to document and take responsibility for their own research judgments. Some editors encourage third-person references to "the present study," while

others may prefer blurring an agent's identity with various passive constructions, or risking too subjective a tone by the abundant use of first-person pronouns. The risks of over-reliance on the wrong option are not trivial. For each, there is also a body of seemingly-contradictory negative editorial commentary to contend with. Seldom do these choices add greatly to, or subtract greatly from, the substantive research claims made in a paper, but they may influence readers' subjective acceptance or rejection of those claims. The present study analyzes a corpus of 269 articles from 31 different journals in business and social science, all published early in the year 2002. A text-analysis accounting is made of different agency devices actually employed by the authors. Regression models are then estimated to control for the most important non-stylistic factors that are known to influence citation counts. Such factors include the length of the article and number of references cited in it, the quality of the publishing journal, the number of co-authors, and their collective citation success with their other articles published shortly before and after. After adjusting for these factors, the information about agency attribution explains a small but significant share of the remaining variation in citation counts received by the surveyed articles within five years subsequent to their publication. These results may offer guidance and reassurance to authors seeking an appropriate stylistic balance or to those negotiating style issues with their editors.
